
\$2,000	Brings a performance to a rural or inner-city school



# Sun.Ergos

(Greek, meaning “*working together*”) is a professional, two-man, international touring-company of theatre and dance whose mandate is to witness, explore and celebrate the similarities and diversities of world cultures in order to promote greater compassion, wisdom and understanding among people everywhere.

**Unique in North America and Europe**, Sun.Ergos’ energetic blend of the performing arts has been compared to the story-telling of the Blackfoot Elders who fascinated their audiences by telling two stories at once, one verbally, the other in movement.

Created with the idea that theatre and dance benefit from collaboration with all other art forms and traditions, Sun.Ergos employs the visual arts with mime, singing, poetry, music, crafts, sculpture, and folk arts in their performances.

## What do we do?

Sun.Ergos performances explore the values, concerns and emotions that we share as human beings, experienced through mirrors of other times and places, reflecting their light on our times.

Through folk-tales from around the world or original scripts, traditional or contemporary dance, we provide lessons of unity and cooperation, exposing foibles and conceits.

Like the Shamen who believe the world to be a single cobweb, Robert Greenwood, actor, and Dana Luebke, dancer, bring stories to life, spinning a web that connects cultures. Meticulous research, authentic costumes and exquisite craftsmanship lend integrity and depth to the experience.

On average, Sun.Ergos completes some 400 events per year of which approximately 300 are held in schools.

We offer **tailor-made** learning opportunities through Community and School Residencies, Performances, Workshops, Master Classes and Lecture-Demonstrations.

Our **professional classes** include acting, directing, speech, design, visual arts, educational kinesiology, choreography, ballet, modern and folk dance. The hands-on sessions create experiences for both students and instructors, increasing the learning opportunity, understanding and results.

## Why are we doing what we do?


By providing extraordinary images from other cultures, Sun.Ergos helps to shape how we see our own everyday life more clearly, and that often leads to real change in peoples’ lives.

Sometimes a talking-animal character and the liquid form of a dancer can provide more of an awareness, a compassionate **insight into our own lives**.

They give us the aesthetic distance to see without judgement, to hear without prejudice, to feel without fear, to smile with recognition at our own mistakes and, more importantly, to realize relevant truths about ourselves.

## Who is our audience?

Sun.Ergos has performed in **17 different countries** touring in both rural and urban areas to communities, festivals, schools, colleges and universities, as well as reserves and refugee camps. Our audience becomes dynamically involved – an integral part of our performances – as Robert and Dana take the action to them, convinced that the audiences’ reactions, responses and experiences are the product Sun.Ergos creates.



## Changing Lives

Sun.Ergos builds **cultural bridges** by helping people to recognize the similarities and to celebrate the differences of our human mosaic.

Whether bringing Arabs and Israelis together in Akko, introducing English story-telling to Cantonese speakers in Kowloon or creating laughter with refugees in Croatia, Robert and Dana are pioneers who **change and enhance peoples’ lives**.

## Self-Contained

Sun.Ergos is also unique in that research, design, script-writing, costume, set and prop construction, promotion and administration are done in-house by Robert Greenwood and Dana Luebke.

Sun.Ergos is a **totally self-contained entity**.
